2. Students who get regular medical checkup

(1) Chest X-ray Examination Chest

X-ray examination is mandatory for 1st year students. Please tell us if you cannot take the examination.

X-ray examinees should come in plain, lightweight T-shirts that are easy to put on and take off.

(2) Electrocardiogram

1st year students can take Electrocardiogram.

3. Inspection items

Height, Weight, Urinalysis, Blood Pressure, Eye Sight, Chest X-ray Examination, Electrocardiogram

4. Notes

①Please print out the "学生定期健康診断個人調査票/ Medical Checkup Record " from Live Campus, fill out the required information and bring it on medical checkup.

②Please receive the urinalysis kit at your academic affairs office. You can take urinalysis when having your period. Please collect urine by using the kit in morning of medical checkup day and bring it.

③Please bring student ID card.

④Please measure your body temperature before coming to university. If you have a fever or cough, please take medical checkup on another day.

⑤Please see the time table. If you cannot take on designated time, please contact to International Exchange Center.

5. Extra date of medical checkup

If you cannot take the medical checkup on the above date, please take on extra date.

6. Health Certificate

You can get the certificate of medical checkup from certificate issuing machine about 1 month later.
